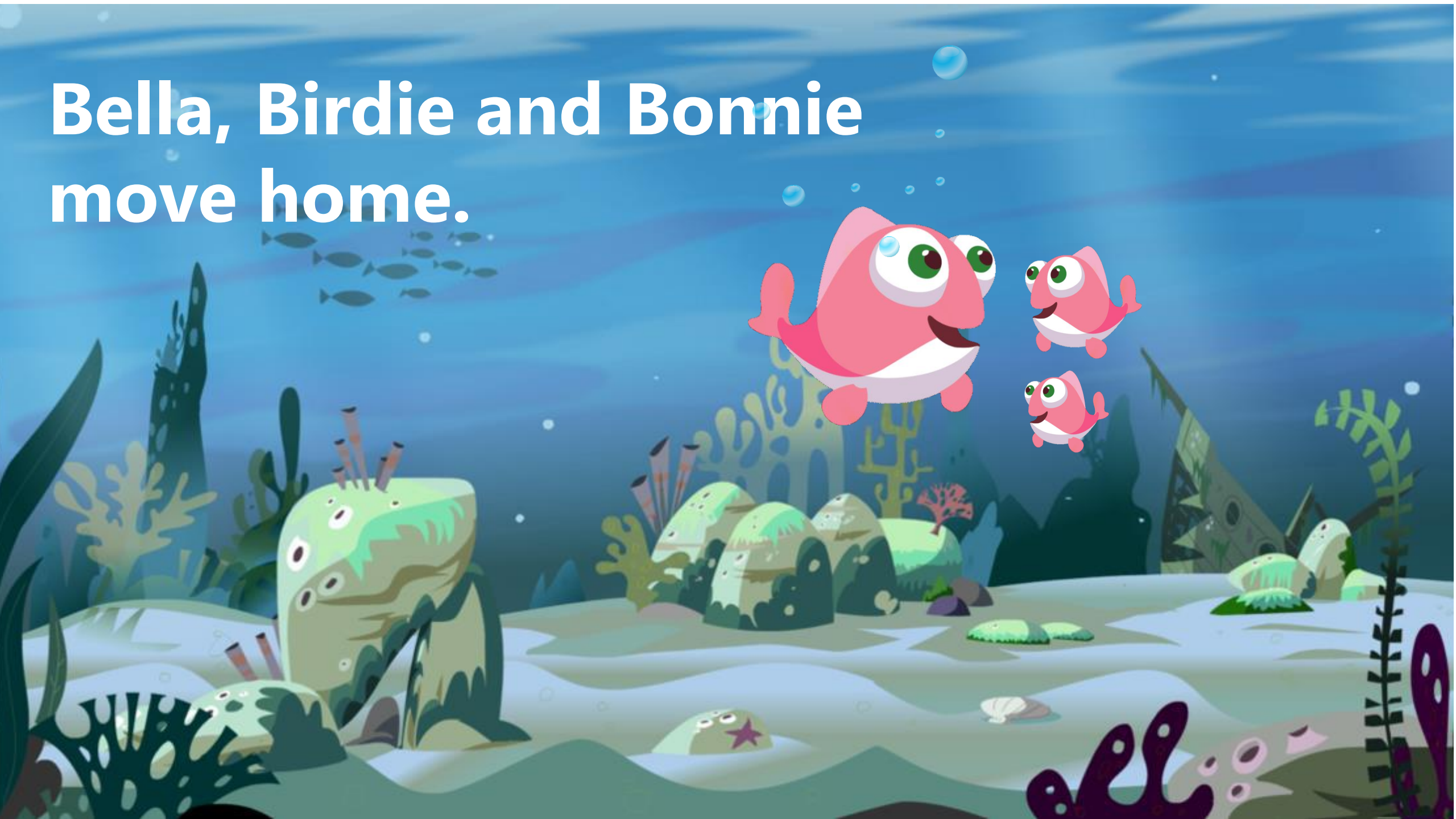


**Bella, Birdie and Bonnie
move home.**

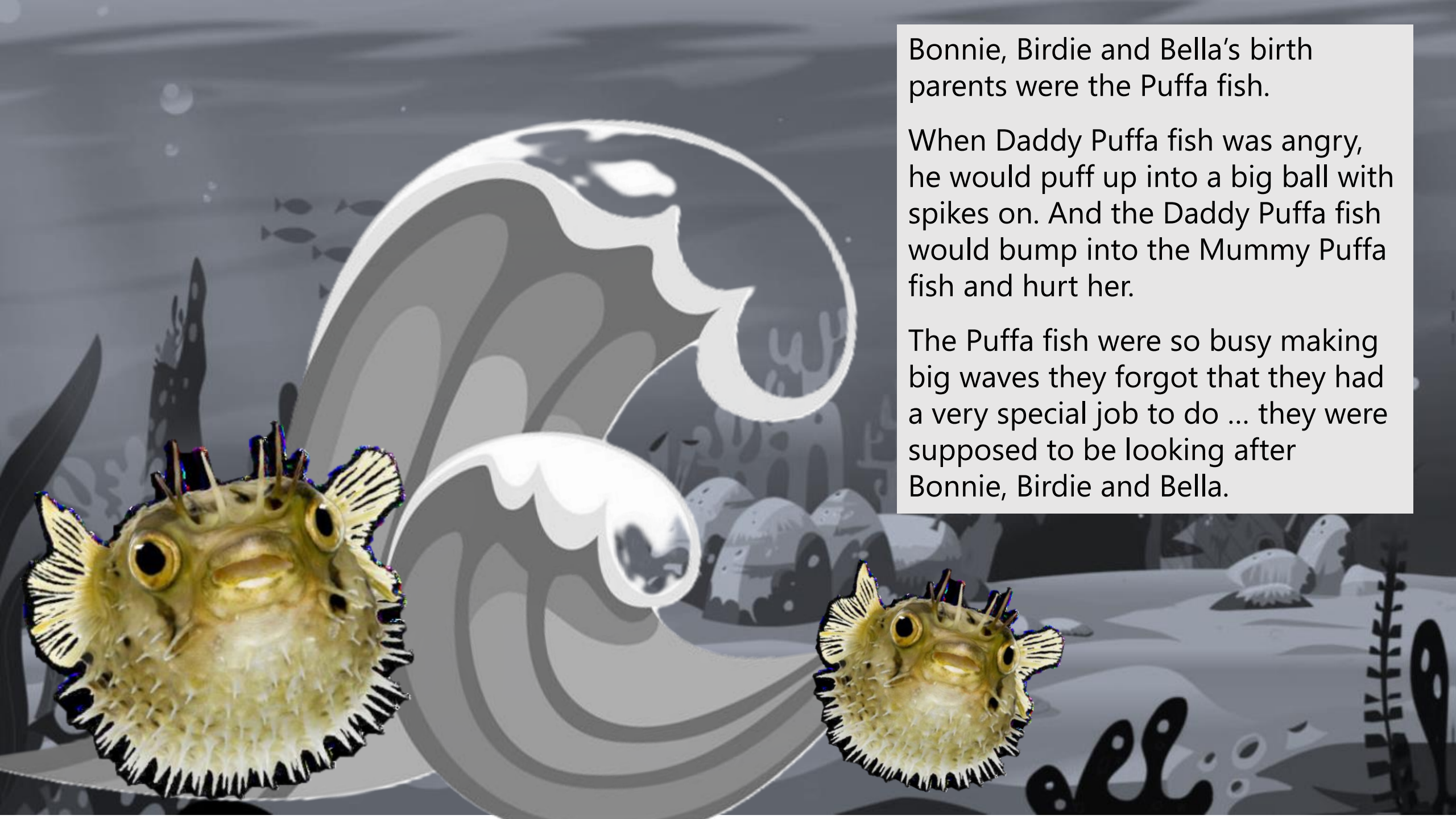




Once upon a time there were three beautiful little fish called Bonnie, Birdie and Bella.

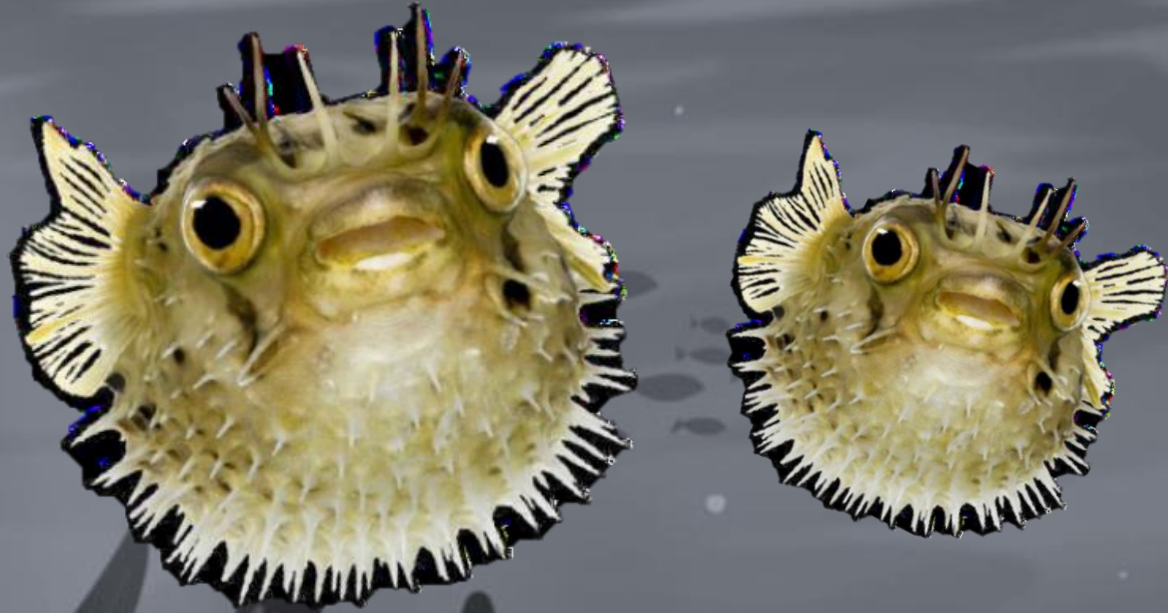
But it wasn't always like this...

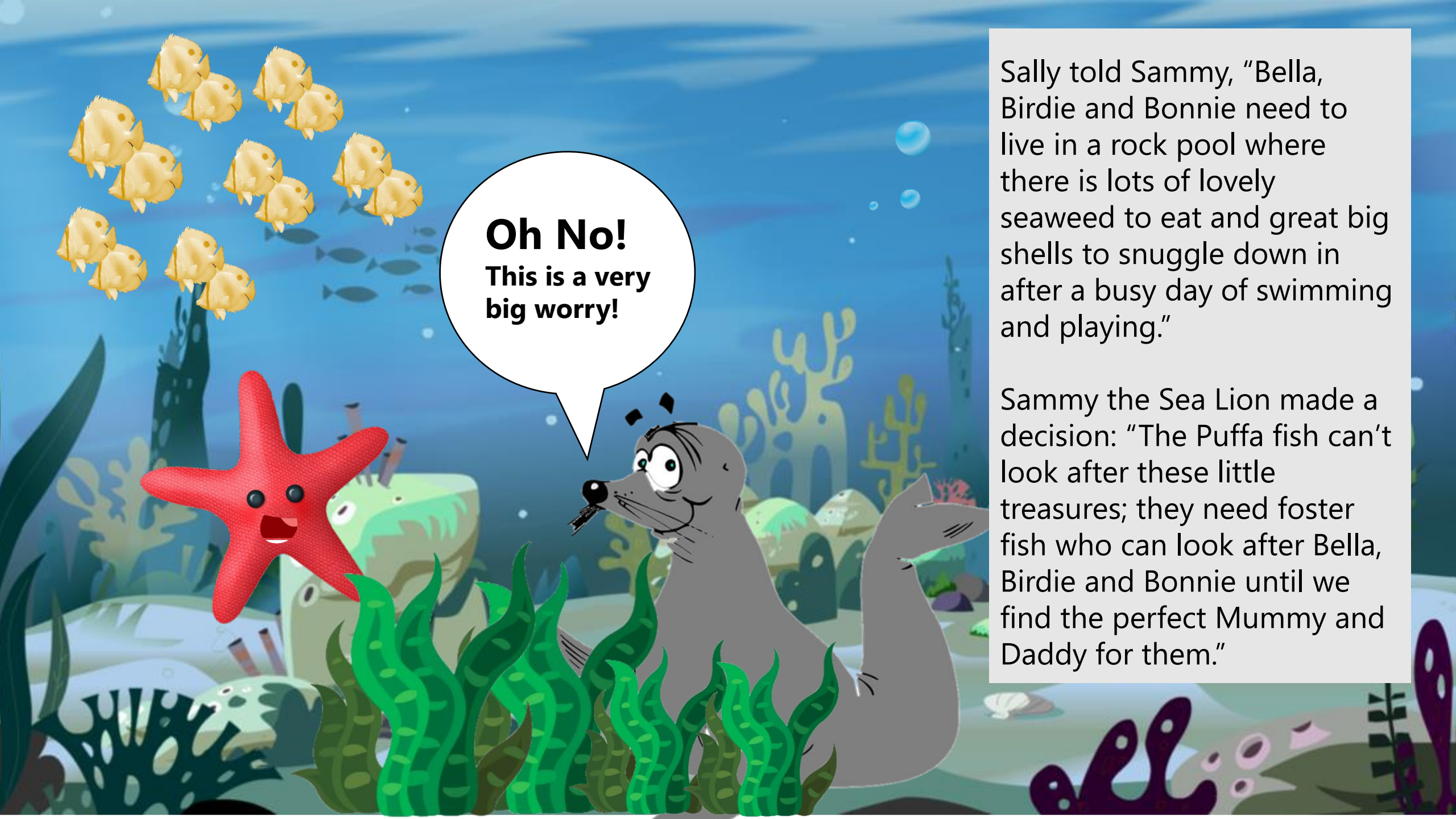




My name is Sally Starfish. I'm worried about Bella, Birdie and Bonnie.

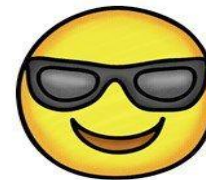


How are Bella, Birdie and Bonnie feeling now?
