Hello my name is Buddy. And I am a puppy and go 'Woof Woof'. Can you make a woof noise too?

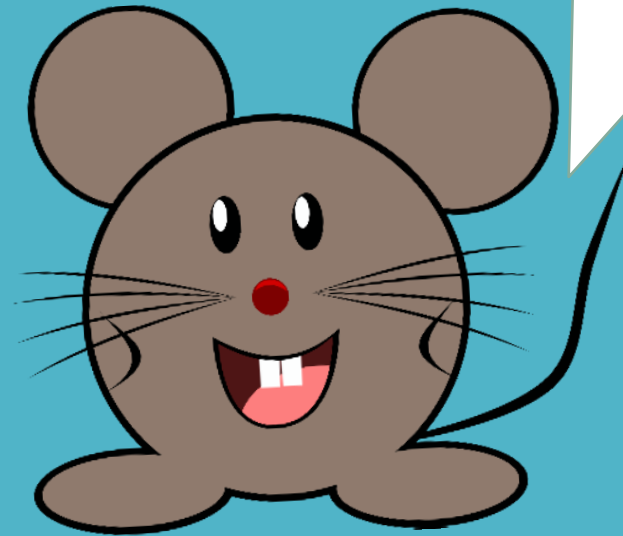


Meet Mrs Mouse.

Is this a secret or a surprise?

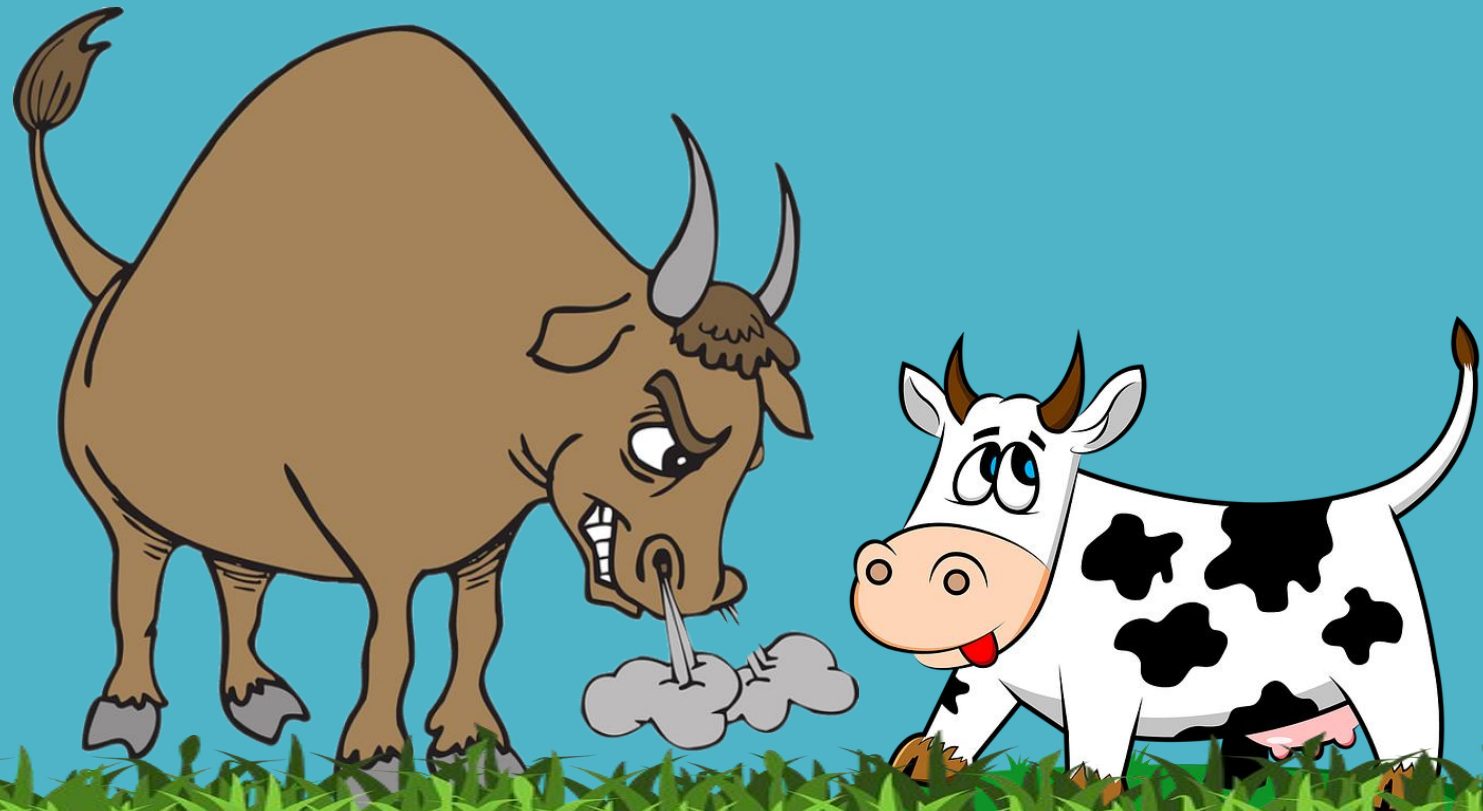




Bully is being mean to Daisy cow
