Liora was kind and brave, but life had been a bit windy and stormy for her and she wasn't safe anymore.

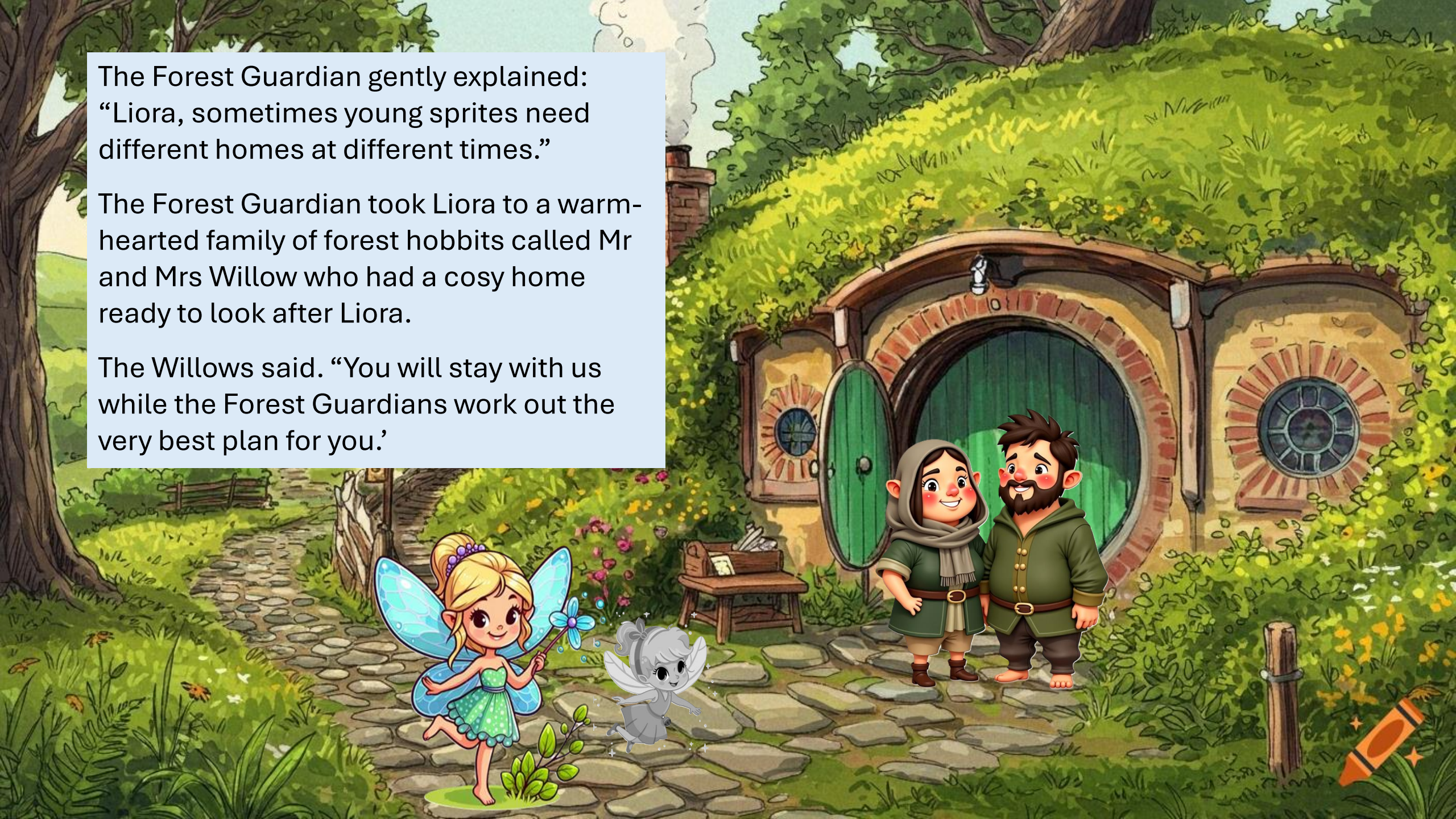

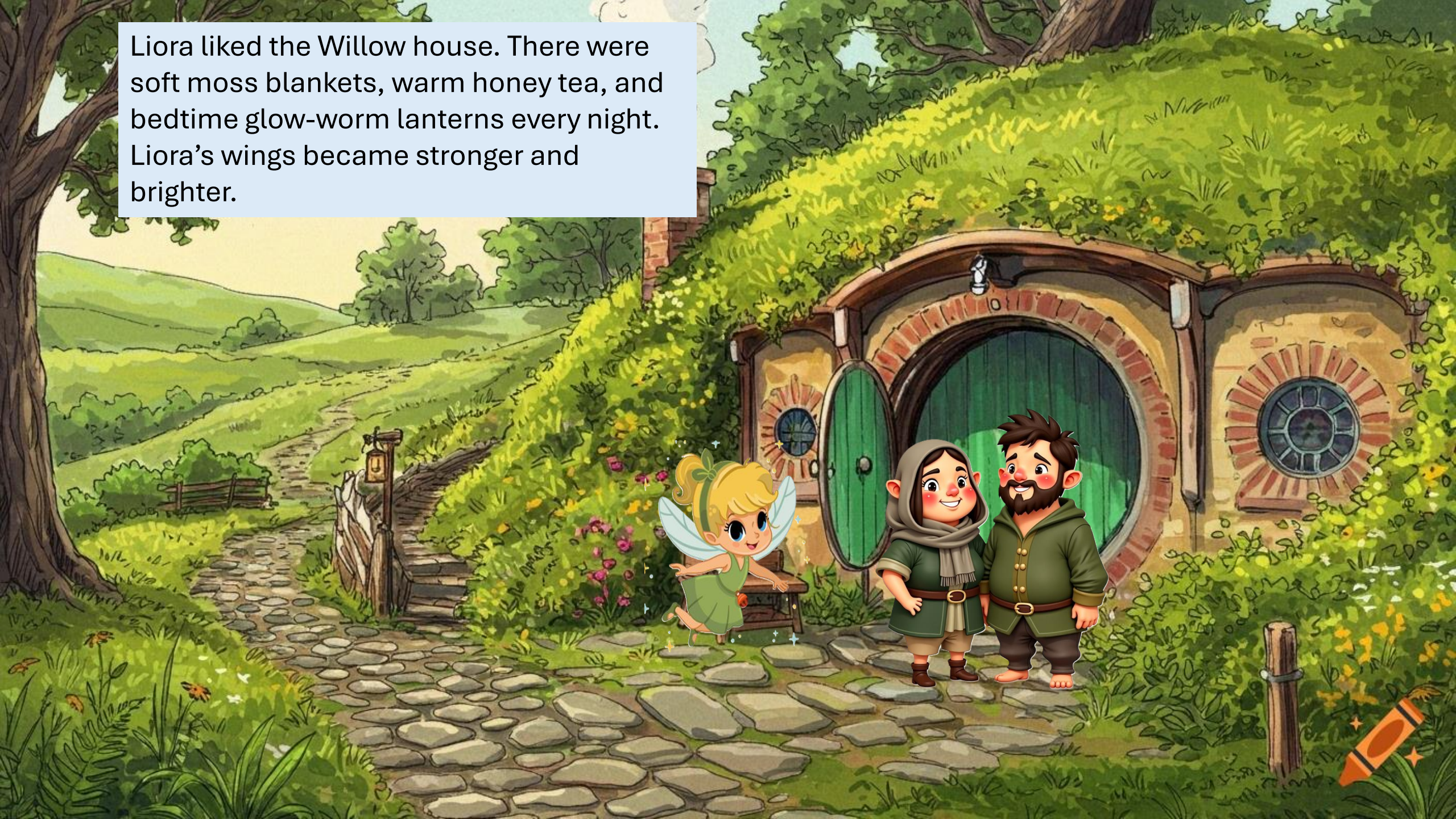
The Forest Guardian gently explained:

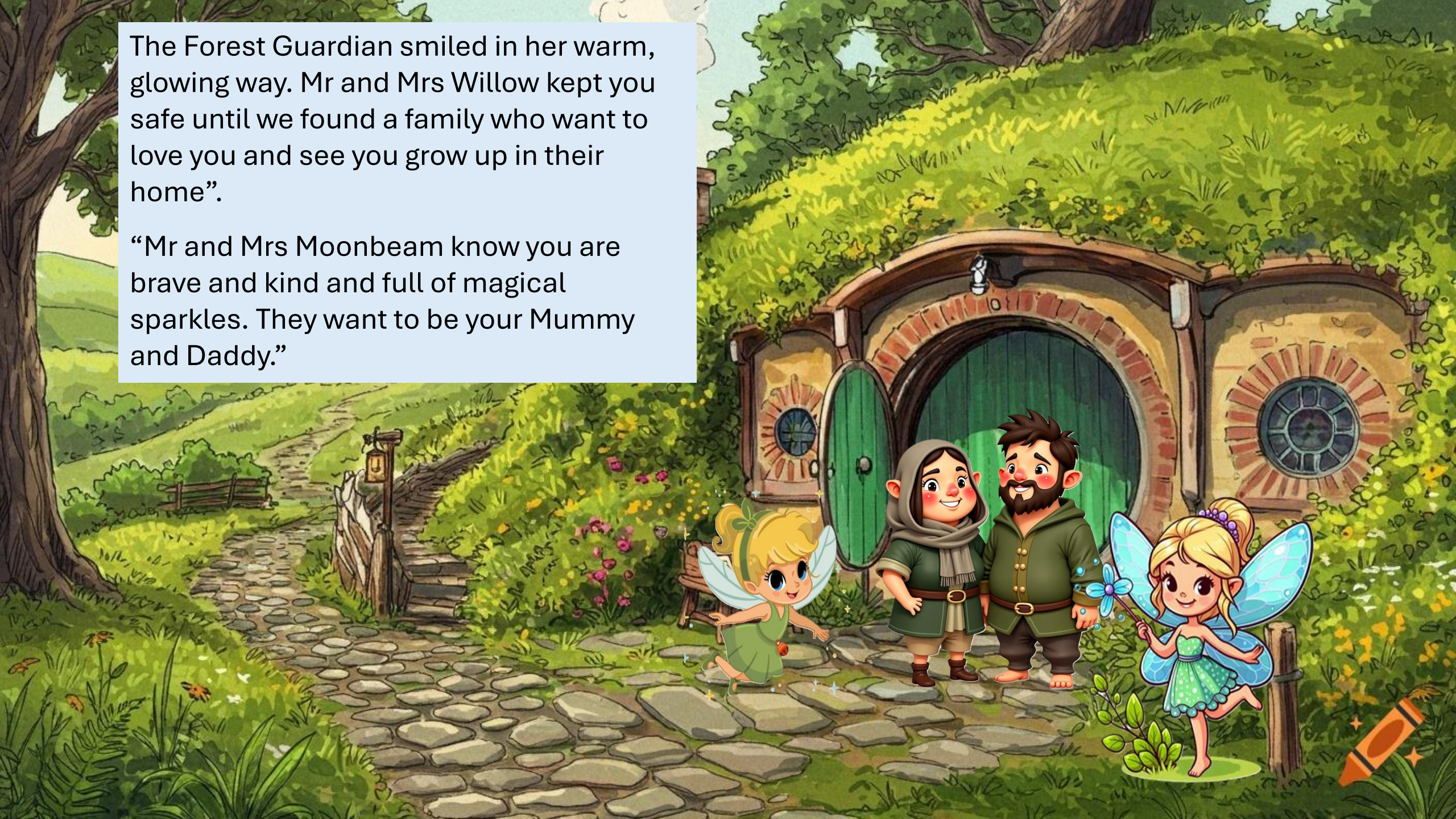
